



Introduction to Stock


In this video you will learn about recording stock information in the Enterprise Livestock pack.

You add animals to FarmIQ by setting up mobs. You can also track what paddocks the stock is in.

On the Enterprise pack you can record information against EID tags.

Using EID in FarmIQ means you can track and report the performance of individual animals.

FarmIQ tracks stock numbers and maintains a stock reconciliation.



To view the stock reconciliation, click **Stock**, **Add remove stock** then **Stock Reconciliation**



If you want the stock reconciliation and your record of stock events to be accurate, record all stock movements on and off farm - such as sales, purchases and grazing.



To set up your stock list you first need to add your animals to FarmIQ. To add existing animals on your farm, go to **Office**, **Add existing stock**.

On the Enterprise pack, when managing stock, you can click **Add tags** to use an EID tag file to load the information about your animals.

The stock list shows you the Mob, stock classes, paddock and tally of all animals you have recorded on your farm. If the mob contains EID tags they will display a tag by the mob name.
