


Introduction to the Mobile App

In this video you will learn about the FarmIQ mobile app, where you can get it, what it does and how it works.

You can get the app from the Google Play Store or download it from the Apple App Store.



Log into the mobile app with your FarmIQ username and password.

Use the FarmIQ mobile app to record events while you are out on the farm. For example, a Health and Safety incident.


Let's take a quick tour of the app.




The diary shows you activities that have been recorded on your farm.



You can adjust the filters to customise your view of the diary.




Tap the menu icon to open the menu, or swipe from the left to drag it out.




Tasks shows you work that has been allocated to you.




Map shows you a map of your farm. You can zoom and rotate the map, and display paddock names, hazards, emergency locations, emergency equipment and features.




To do list allows you to manage the farm To do list and Shopping list. You can add items to be done and mark off items on the list as completed.



Stock is where you record stock events.




Land is where you record land applications and weather.




In **Health and safety**, you can record Hazards, Incidents or Safety interactions, and visitors.


Timesheets is where you record your hours worked.



Office is where you manage your product inventory, upload files and view farm plans.
