



# Recording Stock Events

In this video you will learn about recording animal events in FarmIQ for internal and compliance records.

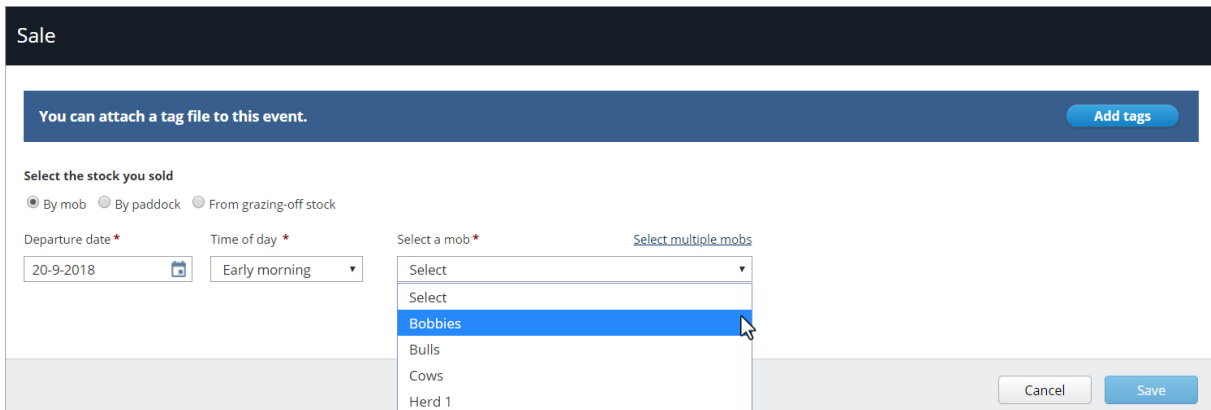


For example, I am going to record the sale of some bobby calves.

To record a sale, click **Stock > Add remove stock > Sales**.

You can sell animals from a mob, or if you know the paddock they were in, sell out of a paddock.

I am going to sell some bobbies.



Enter the departure date and select the mob.

If you are selling out of multiple mobs, you can select all the mobs at once.
