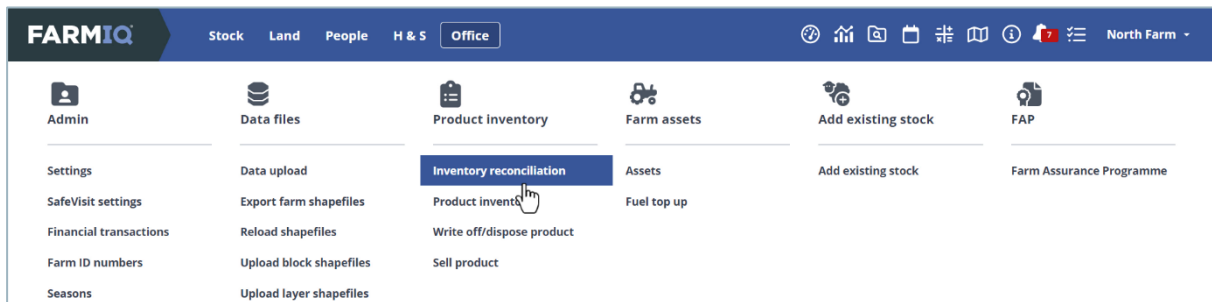




Viewing the Product inventory reconciliation

In this video, you will learn how to set up and view the Inventory reconciliation report in FarmIQ.

The Inventory reconciliation report shows the quantities of products and batches on your farm for a selected date range.



Click **Office**, **Product inventory** and **Inventory reconciliation**.

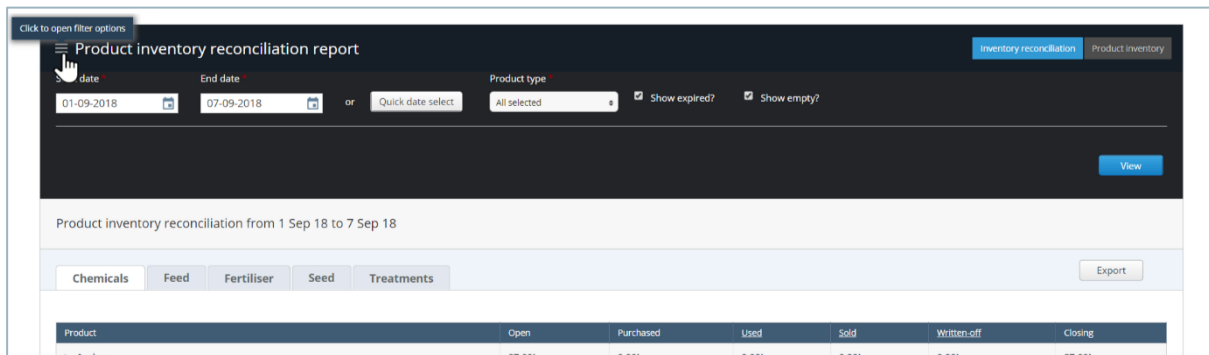
Product inventory reconciliation report

The report selects the current month as the default timeframe and shows all products.



You can adjust the date selection by clicking the filter and selecting a new **Start** and **End date** or using **Quick date select**.

You can also adjust the selected **product types** and whether to **show expired** or **empty** batches.

Once you have set up your report criteria, click **View**.
